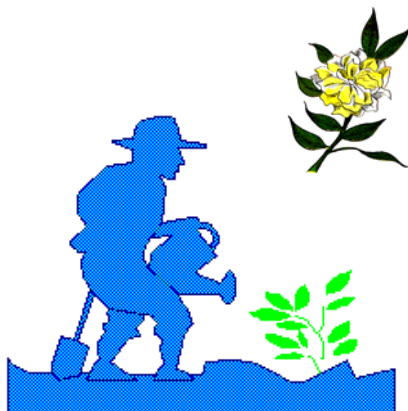

2. All exhibits will become the property of the Pine Rivers A H & I Assn to sell at end of show (except Children's section entries)
3. Entry fee 60 cents per class
4. All exhibits accompanied by appropriate entry form to be delivered to the pavilion by Thursday 29th July, 2010 2.00pm – to 6.30pm and must be staged ready for judging at 7.00pm.
5. Prize money 1st - \$5.00 2nd - \$3.00 (unless otherwise stated)
3rd place will receive a place card only
If there are fewer than three entries in any class, only 1st place prize money will be awarded.
Any prize stated above may be substituted with a trophy or voucher to that value
6. Points allocated 1st = 3 2nd = 2 3rd = 1
7. Show Society will supply baskets if required
8. Prizes to be collected no earlier than 4.00pm and no later than 5.00pm Sunday 1st August, 2010
